

High School Graduation Rate Fact Sheet for Gwinnett

What You Need To Know About the New Graduation Rate Calculation

Gwinnett County Public Schools is using the new four-year adjusted cohort rate calculation method. All states and school systems that receive Title I funds must use the new method. You can now compare school graduation rates across the country since they will be using the *same* calculation method. The cohort method is defined as:

Number of cohort members who earned a regular high school diploma by the end of the 2010- 2011 school year

Number of first-time 9th graders in fall 2007 (starting cohort) plus students who transfer in, minus students who transfer out, emigrate, or die during school years 2007-2008, 2008-2009, 2009-2010, and 2010-2011

Under the old system, schools were able to count students who took more than four years to graduate. Also, schools counted dropouts only as those students who had declared their intentions not to return to school. Now, if the school cannot verify that a student who has left the school has transferred to another school then that student is counted as a dropout.
